- **a.** NECAP data for grades 3-8. Kim Schroeter presented NECAP Data for the district and individual elementary schools for 2012. The Target % has not been determined as the NCLB waiver has not been passed. Kim noted issues with various classes' progress or lack thereof stating that the cohort may be too small in some classes to properly reflect any change. In some classes the issue influencing the change in proficiency may be related to a choice of curriculum.
