- 1) Christina Wotton and Julie Turner facilitated the tour of the Union Elementary School:
  - a. Outside Building Maintenance
    - 1. Front Entryway
      - a. Apple Trees by the entrance of the school need to be removed as they are causing safety issues (slipping/allergies)
      - b. Refacing the front of the school to say "Union Elementary School"
      - c. The inlaid mat inside the doorway and the tile need to be replaced.
      - d. Columns by the front entryway need to be repaired/replaced.
      - e. Some of the bricks are falling apart (exit outside on gym floor).
    - 2. Parking Lots/Tarred spaces –

- Resurface basketball court. Tar is breaking and surface is cracked and uneven. Basketball hoops need to be repositioned.
- b. Parking lot needs to be repaved, badly uneven.
- c. Wing exit needs new pavement, badly uneven, falling hazard.
- d. Central Office walkway needs to be repaved.

# b. Inside Building

- 1. Lobby bathrooms and Nurses bathroom need new floors, they are badly cracked.
- 2. Kitchen floor needs to be replaced, badly cracked.
- 3. Gym lights need to be on a switch.
- 4. Lunch room tables need to be replaced.
- 5. Showers in bathroom need to be addressed broken handles, no shower curtains.
- 6. Map in hallway needs to be repaired.
- 7. New blinds in classrooms, many need to be replaced.
- 8. Roof in Joanie's room and window.
- 9. It was noted that some classrooms have too much clutter and cloth animals (cloth animals need to be removed from classrooms).
- 10. Some classrooms have way too much paper on the wall; unsprinkled building only allowed 20% of wall space to be covered.
